2027 Summer Program

- 2L summer associates have the opportunity to spend four weeks during the summer in one of our overseas offices. Overseas placements are made based on the needs of each overseas office as well as language ability and practice area interest, among other factors (minimum 9-week commitment required).
- Candidates should have an anticipated graduation date of spring 2028 and must be able to participate in Cleary's 2027 summer program for a minimum of 7 consecutive weeks.
