From 2010 to 2011, Mr. Mehrotra led the firm's investment banking business for the Middle East and North Africa and was based in Dubai. He was named managing director in 2004 and partner in 2010.

Prior to joining the firm, Mr. Mehrotra held various positions at Intel, Morgan Stanley and McKinsey & Company.
