Fedida's tax expertise also extends into M&A, where he has worked on deals like the TPG, PAG Asia Capital and OTPP acquisition of DTZ and the subsequent acquisitions of Cassidy Turley and of Cushman & Wakefield by DTZ. Fedida distinguishes himself as trilingual (fluent in English, French and Hebrew) and is a member of the New York Private Investment Funds Tax Forum.
